**Walker v NSW Department of Premier and Cabinet (NCAT file
2017/226200)**

I refer to the above proceedings.

As you know, the Respondent's evidence and submissions filed and served on 20 October 2017 indicated that the Respondent:

- (a) submits that there were reasonable grounds for classification of Records 21 and 22 as Cabinet information and, accordingly, that the Tribunal should affirm the decision to refuse access to those records; and
- (b) does not press its claim against disclosure in relation to Records 1-20 and 23-25.

I am instructed to seek your consent to the Tribunal making the following order:


