



Night work on Wakehurst Parkway, Frenchs Forest from Monday 30 November

The NSW Government is upgrading roads around the new Northern Beaches Hospital with work proposed to be completed in time for the hospital opening in 2018.

Roads and Maritime Services will carry out traffic management activities at the intersection of Wakehurst Parkway and Frenchs Forest Road to prepare for the start of construction of the Stage 1 Connectivity Work.

The work includes:

- Establishing traffic controls
- Installing barriers and site fencing to ensure the work zone is safe
- · Painting new line marking
- Installing environmental controls.

This work will be carried out in four shifts of night work from **Monday 30 November** to **Sunday 6 December**, weather permitting. Our working hours will be from **7pm** to **6am**.

Further night work will be required to complete the project and residents and businesses will be notified before any night work starts.

How will the work affect you?

There will be some noise associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise noise by working only at night where necessary, using flexible noise shields to dampen noise, and noise monitoring. Lighting towers will be directed away from residential properties.

Traffic changes

Changes to traffic conditions including lane closures will be in place to ensure the work zone is safe. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
